

Larch Hills to host first Teck Okanagan Cup of 2014-2015 season

(Salmon Arm, BC) – The first Teck Okanagan Cup cross-country ski race of the season will be hosted at the Larch Hills Ski area in Salmon Arm December 27-28th, 2014. Racers of all ages and ski ability from the Thompson/Okanagan are invited to compete for medals and points.

Club points are accumulated for each race in the Teck Okanagan Cup series and an award is given to the club with the most points at the end of the final race. Points are earned for top-5 finishers and for participation. All clubs are encouraged to attend all three races, including the races on Jan 10th in Kamloops and on Jan 31-Feb 1st in Penticton.

The Larch Hills Ski Club is looking forward to hosting the two day Teck Okanagan Cup event, featuring a mass start classic distance race on Saturday and skate sprints using kings court format on Sunday.
